Introducing eConnect API

The one stop solution for large e-commerce customers in Europe. When using this interface, your system is directly connected to the eConnect service via RESTful-API. It consists of the following core operations:

- n Shipment
- n Custom
- n Event

DHL Group Developer Portal

The DHL Group API Developer Portal supports API documentation for all divisions of DHL Group. Navigating the DHL Group Developer Portal requires orienting on the Division. For general navigation related to DHL eCommerce it is best practice to select 'DHL eCommerce' as the Division and 'Europe' as Region.

Getting Access

As a developer you'll need to request API credentials. Generally speaking, developers only need to access our Sandbox environment for testing and certification, while production access is reserved for active DHL eCommerce account holders from a production environment.

Please refer to your local DHL eCom Europe API experts for a Sandbox account.

Integrator Production Credential Management

On Production Integrators can either use the credentials of each customer with an DHL eCommerce account or for simplified credential management so called “Integrator” credentials can be used. This one set of credentials allows Integrators to ship for all customers assigned to them in the onboarding process without managing individual credentials .

CUSTOMER ONBOARDING

How to create a smooth onboarding experience for our customers.

New customers should be able to go live within days if not hours and should find it easy to configure the DHL eCommerce products and services they want to use within your software.

Before getting into the details of your solution, know that DHL eCommerce has sales and IT onboarding staff around the world that will help customers get ready to ship. They're involved in approving API credentials, validating data quality of the integration, and ensuring all scenarios respective to their business are being handled properly from within the shipping solution.

It's important to note that the larger or more complex the customer, the more validation is required by the onboarding team. Sandbox access is granted first to all requestors after our verification process, and for eCommerce shippers using integrators they're granted production access immediately while direct integrated customers undergo a more thorough data quality validation process.

With customer experience in mind, the sections below provide details on how best to include DHL eCommerce products and services into your solution for the various activities a shipper needs to perform, namely:

- n Configure carriers
- n Select the carrier, transportation product, and any ancillary services
- n Generate label

Carrier Configuration

Shippers will expect to setup DHL eCommerce Europe as a carrier and enter in their specific information. At minimum this will consist of e.g.:

- n CustomerID (or EKP number)
- n Product to use
- n Label size and format

For advanced configuration, there are a number of special services or rules a shipper may want to pre-define. 'Advanced Configuration' will include at minimum:

- n Account number (or Billing number)
- n LocationIDs (defined address setups)
- n Direct Injection Parameters number



CARRIER/PRODUCT NAME DISPLAY

Easy identification of carrier and products at first glance.

As the API is using technical product wording, it is important to display customer and consumer an easy and consistent wording of DHL eCommerce products.

CUSTOMER SHIPMENT CREATION

Customers start shipping after a final check.

For customer to start shipping a final check of all connection is brought out by DHL.

Depending on the agreed scope defined in the Customer Onboarding process, our local DHL eCom Europe API experts will do a final check, which can consist of:

- n Label Test
- n Data Test (cPAN from Integrator; DHL internal systems)
- n End-to-End testing

After that, a Go-live date can be agreed and the customer can start in a hyper-care phase supported by DHL eCommerce.

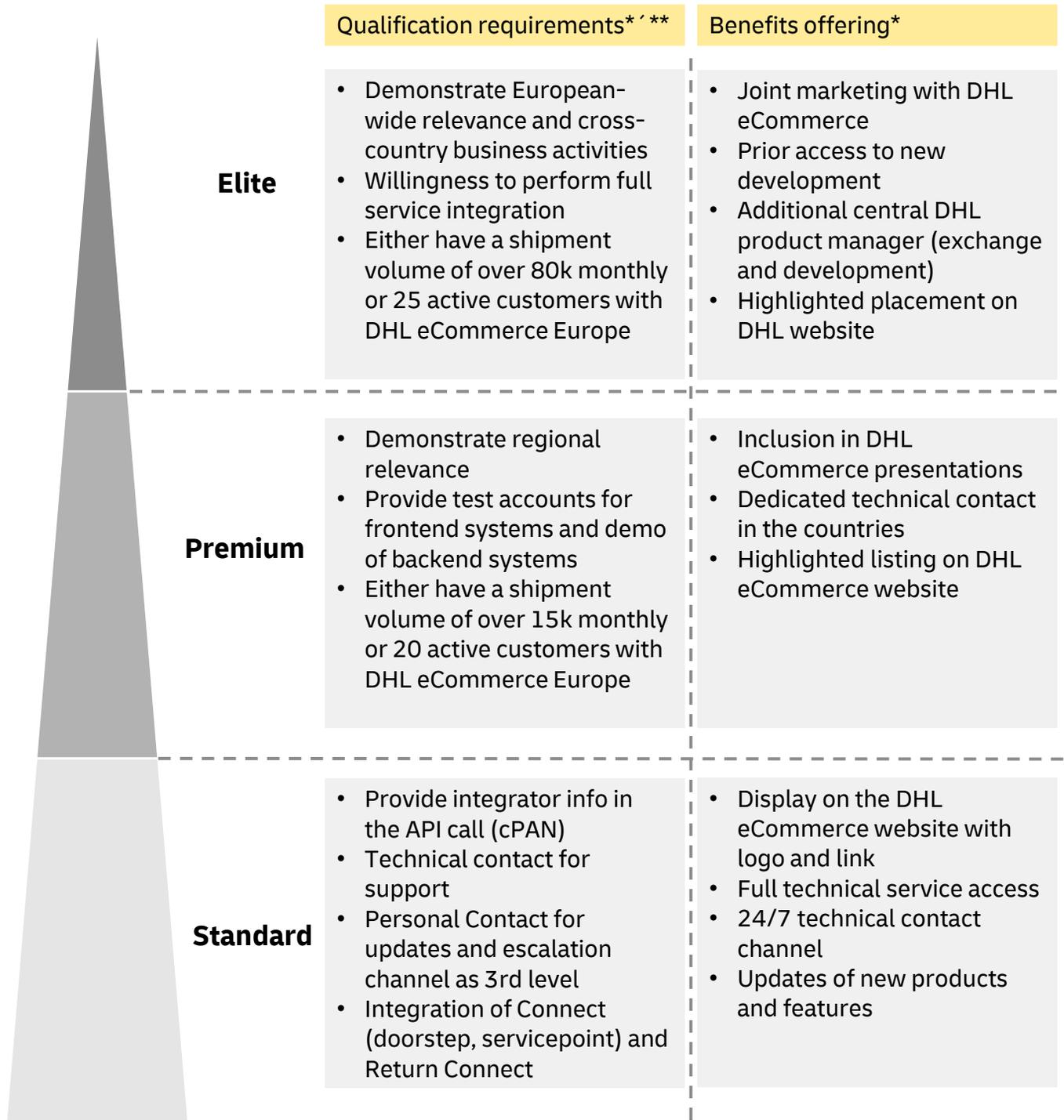

Are there any label requirements?

There is an operational label specification, which needs to be followed by all self labeling integrators. It is up to integrators to include optional features specified in the document, excluded are billable features of DHL (e.g. GoGreen, etc.). Custom Labels must be approved by DHL eCommerce.

The label provided by the DHL eCommerce Europe API is following all specifications and do not require any maintenance by the integrator.

How are implementations/changes financially covered?

DHL is NOT providing any financial support to implement the DHL eCommerce Europe API or provide any changes on integrator side.

Does any tier involve contracts or Service Level Agreements (SLA)?

As standard no tier comes with a contract or SLA on any side. Agreements can be discussed and can be closed on an individual basis.
